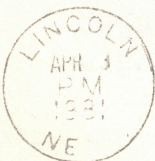
RV-3'S GROUNDED: On April 1, The Lincoln GADO office received a telex related to inflight wing separations during aerobatic maneuvers which have occurred on at least four RV-3's. All currently issued special experimental airworthiness certificates are considered suspended until new operating limitations are issued. It is recommended that an additional operating limitation prohibiting aerobatics be added to all airworthiness certificates. If you know of anyone flying an RV-3, please advise him of this general notice.
