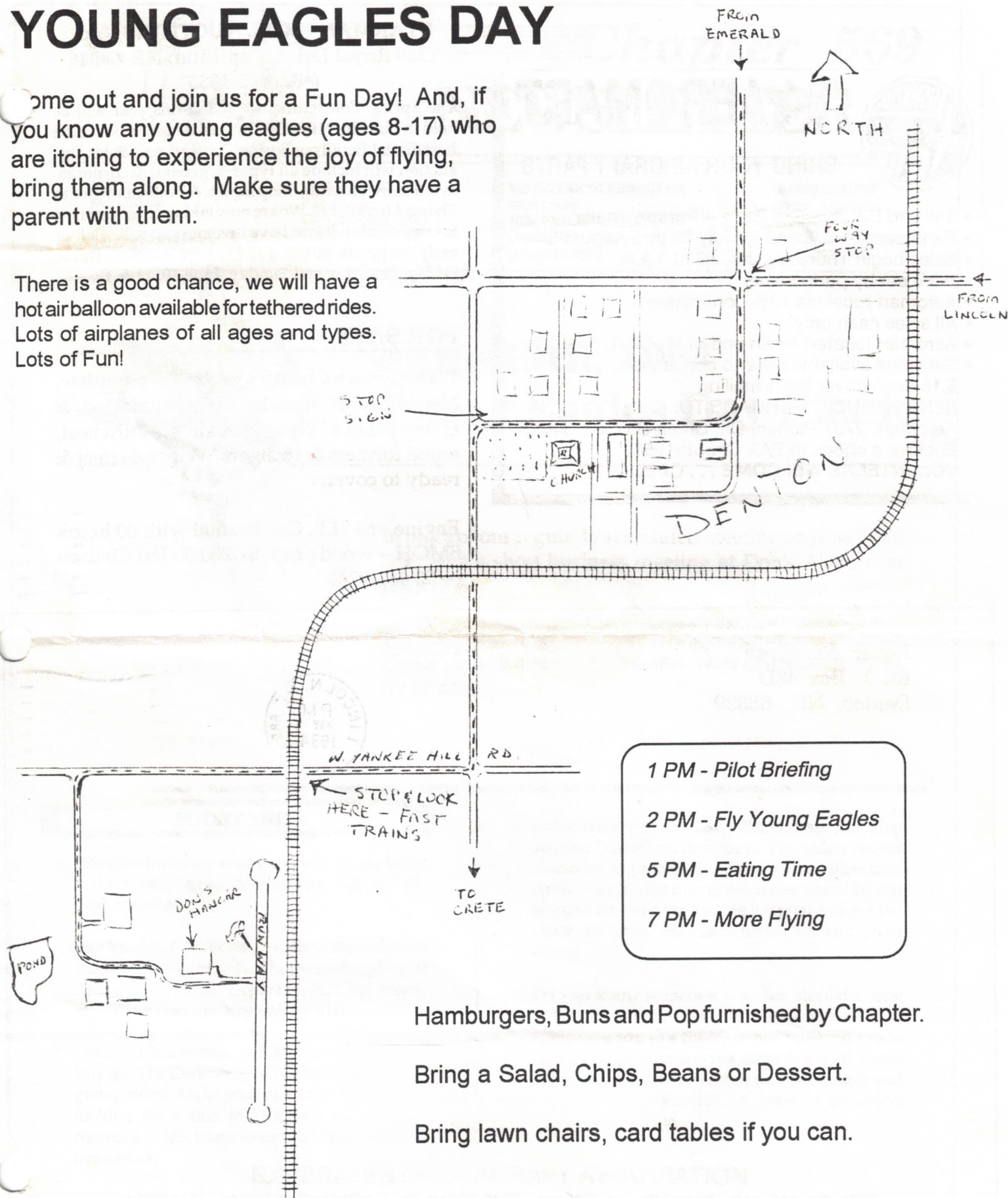
June 12, 1979
