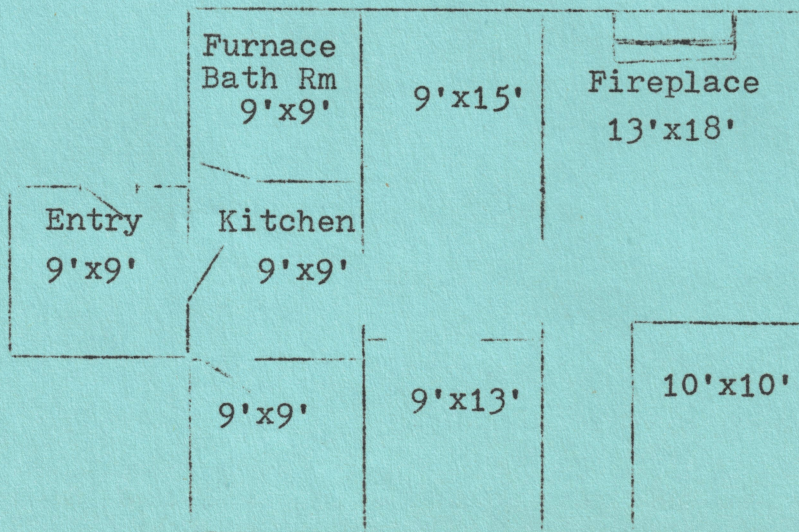
Items Needed
